#### OPIOID PRESCRIBING AND PAIN MANAGEMENT GUIDELINES

Jennifer is a graduate from Cuyahoga Community College Dental Hygiene Program in 2006. She then took her passion for education to The Ohio State University, obtaining her Bachelors of Advanced Education in Dental Hygiene and her Masters of Health Administration in 2018. Since her Graduation from Dental Hygiene School she has practiced hygiene in general and periodontal offices as well as teaching at Lakeland Community College and Cuyahoga Community College. She has a passion for learning, excellent communication skills and a strong ability to adapt to the ever changing world we live in. Jennifer is also a member of the ADHA.

#### Course Description

The Ohio State Dental Board requires mandatory opioid prescribing continuing education for dentists and dental hygienists. This virtual course is approved and in compliance with the re-licensure continuing education requirement. The course will discuss opioid and non-opioid pharmacologic therapy. The mechanism of action, pharmacologic effects, and adverse effects of commonly prescribed medications will be reviewed. Addiction and chronic administration will be covered. The course will discuss addiction treatment and medications used to assist addiction treatment. Considerations for dental prescribing of opioids along with assessment of current and potential signs of drug abuse will be considered. The course will conclude with a question and answer session.

### Continuing Education



#### Boost your health care resume or train for something new.

This course is approved by the Chio State Dental Board and prepares a certified dental assistant, dental hygienist or internationally-trained dentist for the exam to become an Chio Expanded Function Dental Auxiliary. The training covers all topics required to become a registered EFDA and includes a combination of didactic, preclinical, and clinical components.

Classes run once per year on Toledo-area Campus. owens.edu/efda

#### ORAL HEALTH ACCESS SUPERVISION PROGRAM (OHASP)

The Oral Health Access Supervision Program (OHASP) allows dental hygienists with additional required education to practice under relaxed supervision in certain designated underserved locations outside of the dental office without the presence of a dentist. The OHASP allows dentists and dental hygienists to reach out into traditionally underserved locations like nursing homes, schools in dental health resource shortage areas. Head Start programs, WIC clinics and other locations to serve populations who may have had difficulty obtaining dental care.

This course will prepare dental hygienists to practice dental hygiene under the oral health access supervision program (OHASP) following the State of Ohio guidelines. The course outlines the laws and rules that allow a dental hygienist to provide dental hygiene services to patients when the

supervising dentist is not present. This is an eight-hour online course divided into five modules. It will cover topics such as treatment of geriatric, medically compromised, developmentally disabled and pediatric patients; common oral conditions; medical considerations; medications; behavioral management; recognition of abuse; recognition of what constitutes a medically significant change to a patient's medical or dental history; infection control; and ethical and legal considerations. This course meets Revised Code 4715.372/Bi/2l/bi. and all recordiceping practices outlined in board rule 4715-9-01, Revised Code 4715.361 to 4715.375 required by the Ohio State Dental Board in association with the OHASP.

Students will have three weeks from the start date to complete 8 hours of the online, self-study class. Once you are registered, you will receive an email instructing you how to access the course online.

#### LOCAL ANESTHESIA FOR DENTAL HYGIENISTS

Proper anesthesia knowledge, skills and techniques are critical to today's dental hyglenists. This state-approved course combines online study and hands-on clinical at Owens' dental hygiene lab to help you build those skills. The course prepares you to take the Commission on Dental Competency Assessment (CDCA) local anesthesia exam, formerly the NERB exam, which is required for dental hygienists to become credentialed in Ohio. This course has been approved by the Ohio State Dental Board and follows the guidelines in the Revised Code 4715.231 and the Ohio Administrative Code 4715-9-01.1 Please visit OwensWorks.com for a complete course description, prerequisite requirements. Twelve hours of online course work must be completed prior to the first class.

#### NITROUS OXIDE ADMINISTRATION/MONITORING

This course is in accordance with rules 4715-9-01.2 and 4715-11-02.1; register by Jan. 17 with your dental hyglenist or assistant certification. The equivalent of a six-hour course, this course includes a two-hour online didactic course which opens on Jan. 21, plus another two hours of didactic instruction (four-hour didactic total) and two hours of clinical experience. Participants for monitoring must be Certified Dental Assistants or have at least 3,000 hours of experience and hold a current CPR certification. #### MEDICAL EMERGENCIES FOR THE DENTAL PROFESSIONAL

This online course is required by the Ohio State Dental Board for the RDH, OHASP RDH, EFDA and CDA dental team, which allows team members to practice when the dentist is not physically present. The course content is on the identification and prevention of medical emergencies in the dental setting. Participants also will learn the importance of preparation, a team approach to medical emergencies, and the medical history interview. The course has been approved by the Ohio State Dental Board and follows the guidelines in the Ohio Revised Codes 4715.22(C)(2),

4715.363(B)(4), 4715.64(C)(2), 4715.39(D) (2) (b). Students will have two weeks from the date of registration to complete 4 hours of the online, self-study class. Instructor: Debra Manore
